You may be eligible for a Protection from Abuse/Restraining Order if: 1) You and the suspect are in a dating relationship, you have been in a dating relationship in the past; you are currently living together or have lived together in the past, or you have a child in common; and 2) abuse has occurred. This means one of the following has occurred: The person has willfully caused, attempted , or threatened to cause bodily harm to you or a minor child of yours.
